

KEMPEN TROPHY EXHIBITION REGULATIONS

1. Any Gloster breeder may participate in this special show for Gloster canaries. All registered birds must originate from the participant's own breeding stock. The leg rings must be closed and of the correct ring size from the current association. Proof of ownership for the leg rings must be presented.
2. The board is not liable for the death, theft, escape, or damage of birds or the goods of exhibitors or visitors. Sick birds will be removed from the premises or rejected during basketing.
The exhibitor must keep sufficient grain in the cage for the entire duration of the fair.
By participating in the fair, the exhibitor acknowledges these regulations. Exceptions will be decided by the board without recourse. Complaints will be accepted until the end of the fair.
3. All cages accepted by a recognized association are permitted; however, the British Gloster cage with a white or green interior and black exterior is preferred.
The cage labels sent to you should be affixed to the front right, white water bottles to the left.
Filthy cages that are not painted all around will be rejected during basketing.
The bottom of the cages must be filled with sand and/or seed.
4. Birds may be brought in on Friday evening from 6:00 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. or on Saturday morning by 8:30 a.m. at the latest.
Judging of the birds begins at 9:00 a.m. by neutral, specialized judges.
Only board members and helpers are permitted between the shelves before and during the judging.

Exhibitors who are unable to complete a registration form can only participate on Friday, not on Saturday. Basket selection will be conducted in English.

5. Judging will be conducted according to British standards and in the British manner, meaning the judge will rank the birds in their class from first to seventh place. No points or inspection marks will be awarded. After the inspection, the inspector will be available to answer any questions. In any case, the judges' decisions are final. Following the inspection, the show will open to the public at 14:00 PM. The awards ceremony is scheduled for approximately 18:00 PM, followed by basketing. 6. REGISTRATION DEADLINE

7. Entry fee, payable upon basketing:
€2.50 per bird. Absent birds will always be billed.
The flat fee for catalog and administration is €8.00.

8. Rules Master, Novice, Junior:
Champion: At least 5 years as a Gloster exhibitor. Enthusiasts who are judges in any association are automatically Champions.
Novice: Maximum 7 years as a Gloster exhibitor or three times Best Novice Gloster. Enthusiasts who live or breed at the same address compete in the same class. (VB) Sire or Dam Champion, Son or Daughter Champion, Sire or Dam Novice, Son or Daughter Novice.
Junior: 8 to 16 years old, homebred.
